1. We wish you and your association continued success and prosperity.

2. The Korean Federation of Science and Technology Societies (KOFST) will be hosting the second 2018 Young Professionals Forum ('YPF') in Brisbane, Australia. The forum is scheduled to be held from Tue. November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to Sat. November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018, and over 70 Korean scientists and engineers abroad, including Australia, New Zealand, China, Japan, Singapore, Russia, Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan, are expected to participate.

YPF was first introduced this year to establish a forum that aims to encourage mutual cooperation for the purpose of capacity enhancement and fostering of both domestic and overseas young scientists and engineers of Korean heritage, and to build a training and networking platform to nurture the participants to rise as global leaders. As the second YPF will be held in conjunction with the Asia-Korea Conference on Science & Technology 2018 (AKC-2018), we only accept applications from Korean scientists and engineers of the associations located within the Asia-Pacific region.

A Eligibility : Current graduate students or postdoctoral researchers with a science or engineering major and an ability to communicate effectively in English or Korean. Must be born on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1983 or later

\* Postdoctoral researchers must have earned their doctoral degrees within 5 years
