## □ **Objective:**

To arrange a meeting point for any alumni who have previously participated in the Young Generation Forum (YGF), which the KOFST has been promoting since 2002, and the Next Generation Science and Technology Leaders support business(Young Professional Forum(YPF), Exchange and Cooperation program) in order to identify the current status of the next-generation science and technology leaders who will lead the way for the technological innovation of the mother country and to establish a foundation for the continuous networking through conducting mutual exchanges between the alumni.

□ **Period:** December 10<sup>th</sup> (Tue) – 13<sup>th</sup> (Fri), 2019 (scheduled for 4 days and 3 nights)

## □ **Eligibility Criteria and the Number of Participants:**

◦ Eligibility Criteria: Previous participants in the Young Generation Forum (YGF), the Young Professional Forum (YPF), and the next-generation exchange and cooperation programs who are capable of communicating in Korean and English.

\* Previous participants in the YGF (1,848 people), previous participants in the YPF (113 people), Previous participants in the exchange and cooperation programs (79 people)

\* Official language of the forum: Korean

◦ Number of participants: 110 participants

- From overseas: 40 participants

\* only those who have participated in the event since 2010 will be eligible to apply while any 2019 participants will be excluded from the eligibility criteria

- From Korea: 70 participants

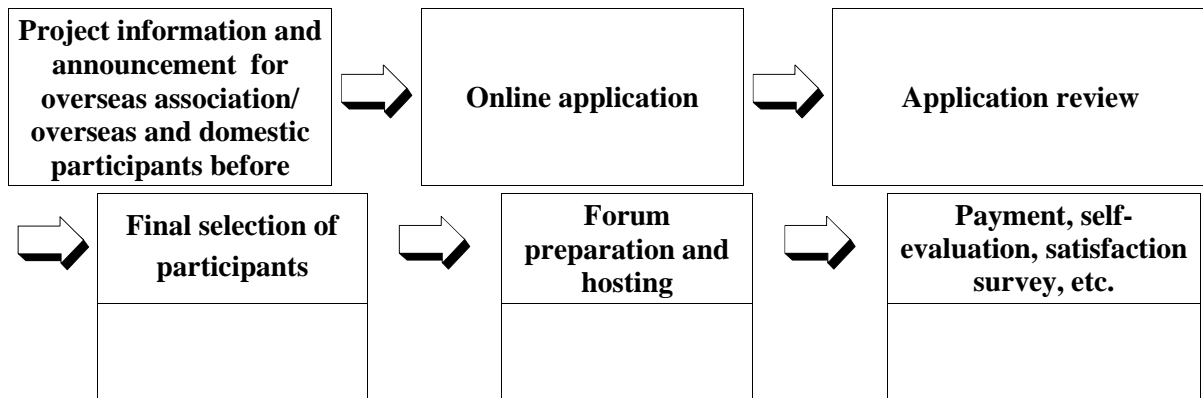
## □ **Detailed Support:**
